On behalf of the [City of Victoria's Emergency Management Division](#) and [Building Resilient Neighbourhoods](#), we are excited that residents in your building have expressed an interest in being part of our "Connect & Prepare" program in April 2021.

Connect & Prepare brings neighbours together to build social connections and strengthen their shared preparedness for different types of emergencies. As part of the program, our team of expert resource people leads participating groups of neighbours through a series of online workshops, and provides additional supports such as resource materials, \$500 worth of shared emergency supplies, and access to other small grants to work on projects and emergency plans together.

We have had great success delivering the program in a wide range of building and housing communities, and we've learned that Connect & Prepare is often most successful when landlords and property managers are supportive and encouraging of increased emergency preparedness among residents. For this reason, if you express support for your residents' application, their application is more likely to be successful.
